- 8. Keep your eye on our #Imustfly YouTube channel or Instagram page for weekly updates on the overall scoreboard.


This exciting event will be taking place until the 30th November '23. One series, four (4) events, enter as many times as you like, the events are based on the Fun Fly series.

- 5. Should there be equal top scores, results will be determined by means of a draw.

Event 3: Roll and Loop for your Life!

Aircraft to take off and climb for 20-seconds. Then perform as many roll and loop sequences as possible. Allowed time is 60 seconds – Type of aircraft - 40 size stick or trainer plane.

Rules:

- 1. Timing start with wheels off the runway, and counting will stop at 60-seconds.
- 2. Each completed roll and sequence will count one (1).
- 3. Maximum count/number of sequences wins.

Entries for event 3 closes on the 27^{th of} October 2023.

Scoring calculated as per Fun Fly score spreadsheet.

Information, requirements, and conditions for proficiency tests

Tests for Solo and Bronze

These tests may be judged by any two members with at least SAMAA Silver status. One flight only required; preflight check and questions must be answered satisfactorily.

Tests for Silver

This test may be judged by any two members with at least SAMAA Gold status. Questions mandatory. Note only one flight required for Silver.

Gold, and Instructor Proficiency tests

Requirement for Gold and Instructor Proficiency: Applicant to complete the Gold and Instructor proficiency application form and email to <u>admin@samaa.org.za</u>, more info in the Fixed Wing Proficiency book.

Tests for Gold

This test will be judged by two members. One Gold and one at least Instructor, both assigned by the SAMAA office. Questions are mandatory.

Tests for Instructor

This test will be judged by two judges, one of whom shall be a SAMAA Instructor and the other a SAMAA Instructor Judge, both assigned by the SAMAA office.

Questions are mandatory.

<u>NB!</u> No pilot will be allowed to do an instructors proficiency test without having first passed the Gold proficiency test.

SAMAA Instructor Judge

After a pilot has obtained his SAMAA instructors' proficiency, he could be appointed as a SAMAA Instructor Judge at the discretion of the SAMAA management committee, provided he fulfills the following criteria.

- a) Shall be a paid-up member of SAMAA and be in good standing with regards to previous payments.
- b) Shall have a minimum of seven years' involvement in model flying.
- c) Shall be mature and shall be respected in the flying fraternity and at his club.
- d) Shall be entitled to judge, together with a SAMAA Gold proficiency pilot, any proficiency up to Gold.
- e) Shall be entitled to judge, together with another SAMAA instructor, a pilot for his Instructor rating.
